- 1. - 2. Brief knowledge and understanding of the performance traditions, genre, ideological and artistic content of the samples, which local style they belong to, mature performers, in what situation, by whom, and on what musical instruments. data collection
- 3. To pay attention to the suitability of the samples selected for singing to the students' psychological and physiological characteristics, musical perception and practical performance capabilities.
- 4. To create and popularize a collection of effective work forms and methods (specifically interesting and meaningful technologies) of working with folk music works.
- 5. Systematic management of various cultural events-concerts, thematic musical compositions, auditions, meetings with famous singer-composers, organizing musical tours for creative teams in the folklore, classical and status directions of folk music. put in

Effective use of opportunities for educational and educational activities carried out in the classroom and extracurricular activities in the high spiritual and aesthetic upbringing of students by means of examples of folk music creation, to make students love and appreciate our national music, and be able to inherit it in the future. as an important skill in their development, it increases the effectiveness of national-musical education.

At this point, it is appropriate to note that the cases of listening, singing, imitating mass pop songs are increasing among young people, and this is the result of the work in the field of musical-aesthetic education not giving the expected results. The only way to fight against such a situation is to protect the growing youth from the destructive effects of "Popular music", by uniting the forces of pedagogues-coaches responsible for education and training towards one goal, national music. It consists in deeply familiarizing with folk songs, classics and status works, which are masterpieces of our culture, and carrying out extensive educational work in order to inculcate them in their consciousness and spirituality.

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
